

TEEN DRIVING SAFETY

RISKS, TIPS & GDL RULES

TOP RISKS FOR NEW DRIVERS

- Inexperience
- Passengers and other distractions
- Speeding
- Lack of seat belt use
- Impaired/drowsy driving
- Driving at night

Half of all crashes happen at less than 40 mph and within 25 miles of home



GDL REQUIREMENTS:

DISPLAY YOUR DECAL



GDL decal must be on each license plate (front/back).

NOT AFTER 11PM



Teens with a GDL are not to drive from 11:01 p.m.- 5:00 a.m. 40% of all fatal teen driver crashes happen at night.

BUCKLE UP

The driver must ensure that they and all of their passengers wear seatbelts.



NO DEVICES



No cell phones, hand held or hands-free electronics, (iPods, GPS, etc.) when behind the wheel.

ONLY 1 PASSENGER

Unless accompanied by a parent or guardian or the passengers are the driver's dependents.

A teen crashes every **11 minutes** in New Jersey.
